

PGM Anywhere testing

Testing Period: 8/13/18 – 8/24/18

General testing: During this period, testers who have completed their specific assignments in Jira should focus on general testing of all aspects of PGMA. This testing should be done on Stage: <https://pgmstage.pgcalc.com/Stage/Home/Login>.

Test all parts of PGMA, compare results to PGMA on production or PGM 7.5A, run in different browsers. Try common and extreme cases. We are looking for about 3 hours/tester per week during the weeks of 8/13 and 8/24. Consult Winston or Bill with questions or to report a possible bug.

Testing issues assigned in Jira

Assignments: Assignments have been made in Jira. You should receive an email when an item is assigned to you.

Testing instructions: See the “Testing Notes” section of each Jira item assigned to you for specific testing instructions. If the item passes, click “Pass UAT” at the top of the screen. If the item fails for any reason, enter the issues you’ve found in a new Comment. Include attachments if you think that would be helpful, then click “Fail UAT” at the top of the screen.

Clientname: Your first name followed by “test”: “Billtest” for example.

Locked out: If you’re told your account has been locked, ask Bill or Winston to unlock your account in the system app.
